RE: **Changes in Sales Tax Reporting**

**For Sales/Use Tax in the area annexed by St. Martinville:**

**Effective April 1, 2006**, an additional one percent (1%) sales and use tax on taxable transactions within the newly annexed area along Highway 31, south of the City of St. Martinville will go into effect. This is in addition to the two percent (2%) collected for the School Board, one-half percent (.5%) for Law Enforcement, one percent (1%) for District No. 2, and four percent (4%) for the state of Louisiana. The **total tax rate** for this area is now eight and one-half percent (**8.5%**). On the reverse side of the newly designed sales tax return (sample enclosed), the applicable street addresses and street names are listed to assist you in identifying this annexed area. Sales, deliveries and use tax in this area will be reported in **Column D**.

The sales tax reporting form for St. Martin Parish has been redesigned to record this new taxation area. Use the column title to correctly report gross sales on Line 13. (For example, District 1 used to be in Column G, but is now in Column I.)

**After April 20<sup>th</sup>, please discard any old forms or copies as their use will delay processing of your return and may cause us to assess a late fee.**
